### Appointments

Fellows are appointed at Strömstad Academy by the Board and are inaugurated at an annual Festival according to: She/he who is or has been full Professor at an accredited University or University College is appointed as Professor. She/he who has been appointed Associate Professor (Swedish: docent) is appointed as Associate Professor. She/he who has a PhD or corresponding degree and who is or has been senior lecturer at an accredited Seat of Learning is appointed as Assistant Professor. She/he who has a Nordic PhD or corresponding degree is appointed as Research Associate. She/he who has a Nordic BA or BSc or corresponding degree is appointed as Research Assistant. Appointments are non-salaried.
